



Making Waves - Music Trainee Brief

Tees Valley Arts is recruiting for a Music Trainee for our Making Waves project, linked with River Tees Rediscovered, Pathways School and Musinc.

Tees Valley Arts

TVA is a participatory arts organisation based in Middlesbrough working across the Tees Valley. TVA designs and delivers creative interventions which help people of all ages, backgrounds and abilities enjoy, engage, learn and make progress in life.

River Tees Rediscovered

The RTR vision is to reconnect the people of the Tees with their river through telling the engaging story of the River Tees as a natural feature that has moulded the physical and cultural development of the landscape and communities through which it runs. TVA is the arts partner for RTR.

Musinc

Musinc leads and supports inclusive music-making with young people from all backgrounds across Teesside.

Pathways School

Pathways School is a special school for 66 pupils aged 6-16 years who have experienced emotional, behavioural and social difficulties in mainstream education. Currently most of the pupils are male.

Making Waves

Pathways School is a small special school which seeks to encourage its pupils to achieve, enjoy and learn across all curriculum areas, but, inevitably, its staff are not able to provide high quality activity in every subject. Currently the school is not able to offer music to its students.

Through this project it is intended that two musicians, one as Music Leader and one as Music Trainee, should work with a group of up to 15 students, all of secondary school age, to help them develop and enhance their own music making skills, whether in playing and singing existing music, or in creating their own original work/s. There will be 10 sessions with the students (to include any celebration/ performance event) which both the ML and the MT will attend. There is an allocation of paid non-contact time for both the ML and the MT which is to be used in familiarisation with the school's existing equipment/ software, in preparation for sessions and editing/ refining works produced after sessions and all other allied project tasks. Both the ML and MT will be expected to attend a briefing session at the school prior to commencement of delivery, due to the particular nature and needs of the students.

A creative writer will also be appointed and will attend three of the ten sessions alongside the ML and the MT; his/her role will be to help the students work on their own lyrics, so that they can understand how to begin to create their own songs, whether in this project or in the future.

The River Tees is to be used as a creative stimulus for any original work/s, whether in terms of its history, its local importance, its moods in different weathers and lights, its tidal rhythms, what lives in it, etc. – whatever the students particularly respond to.

It is envisaged that there will be a celebration/ performance event at the end of the project, but the scale and nature of this (e.g. other pupils attending, parents invited etc.) will be determined in consultation with school personnel, and will be subject to the progress and confidence of the group – developing enjoyment and confidence will be the absolute key aim for this group.

It is envisaged that recording/s will be made of works created/performed by the group and the ML and MT will liaise with school personnel as to how/when this is to be done.

Safeguarding

Genres

After consultation with the young people at Pathways, it has been decided that the chosen music genres are **hip-hop, rap, dubstep and heavy metal**. All artists will need to work within these genres.
